

## Baby Box

### Needed

- Wood Box
- Flowers (Scrapbook Sally)
- White Acrylic Paint
- Green Acrylic Paint
- Crackle medium
- Flower paper
- Mesh ribbon by magenta
- Charm from Making Memories
- Stickers from Sandy Lion

Start by painting the top of the box with white acrylic paint. Allow this to dry completely. Cover this with crackle medium and let dry over night or completely. Now your top color is ready. We chose bright green. Try to paint in one direction and you will see the paint crackle your white will show through. Once this is dry apply your stickers and flowers. I used Sandy lions flower print to cover the bottom of the box and finished it on the bottom with magenta's Green Ribbon Attached with the charm. Scrapbook Sally's bright flowers work wonderful with the box so we double them up and added some pink brad in the middle. If the baby is a boy you just alter your color scheme. It makes a nice gift or gift box for the new addition.
